These two, weekend long trainings will introduce participants to a rationale, methodology and tool set for developing healthy communities of children and their families in center-based, family child care, and school environments. Topics covered will include identifying and understanding the many challenges facing families, communities, and children in their everyday life that create stress and violence. Participants will gain strategies and tools for developing and supporting positive self-image, personal empowerment, empathy, anti-bias perspective, peaceful problem solving and community building in children and teachers that can extend to families and the larger community. Additionally, participants will gain leadership skills, effective communication strategies, problem-solving and advocacy skills. Emphasis is on valuing diversity and respecting individuals; active, experiential learning and the interaction between theory and practice.
